Essential Functions

General duties include: (With Supervision) Installing natural gas mains, gas taps, service lines, gas appliances and meters; welding plastic pipe; checking and repairing gas leaks; locating valve boxes and gas mains; marking locations to comply with Tennessee One Call; operating light duty vehicles, a generator, plastic pipe welder, leak detector, pipe and valve locators, CO detector, odorometer, CGI meter, electrofusion machine, and hand tools such as shovels, hoe, rake, wrenches, etc.; Independently; Handles lighting pilots, and turning service ON/OFF for customers; cleaning vehicle and provided equipment; May also be required to operate a backhoe or trencher; Performs other duties as assigned.
